Patient Information CLINICAL

Clinical pharmacist: Murray Dick is working one day a week at the health centre. You can book an appointment with Murray for medication reviews and advice and simple asthma checks.

NHS Health checks: you can make an appointment for a health check at Reception. NHS health checks are free and for patients in the 40-74 year age group without a pre-existing condition. Patients receive an invite for a health check every five years. If you are eligible and have not had a health check you can make an appointment at Reception. Phlebotomy appointments:

- There is very high demand for our phlebotomy (blood) appointments.
- Please call or email our Reception team to cancel an appointment if you cannot attend.
- May we remind patients that these appointments are five minutes only and ask that you remove your coat before your appointment.
- · Please note that there is a lead time for blood clinic appointments with us due to the pressure on the service.
- Please advise our Reception team in advance if the blood test is for a hospital request, warfarin or GP request to help our staff.

Patient assessment machine: Patients can use the new patient assessment machine in the waiting room to record their blood pressure, height and weight. This information is automatically uploaded to our clinical system.





PACE-UP

PACE-Lift - 2 steps forward! Local walking trial shows reduced heart attacks, strokes and fractures!

Many of you who were aged 60-75 in 2011 took part in the PACE-Lift pedometer walking trial, which was run here at Sonning Common Health Centre and also at Balmore Park and Priory Avenue Surgeries.

We showed that a 12-week walking intervention using a pedometer to measure steps and simple behaviour change techniques to help build long-term habits, could lead not only to more brisk walking at 3 months, but also at 12 months and even 4 years later! We carried out a similar, but larger trial in South London (PACE-UP) which had similar positive results.

Most PACE-Lift and PACE-UP trial participants consented to health record checks to look for important health outcomes.

We found significantly fewer cardiovascular events (heart attacks/strokes etc.) and fractures in those who had worn the pedometers.

Participants also talked about the long-term changes that they had made, with the pedometer 'kick-starting them' and the physical, mental and social health benefits that they felt from getting out and walking more. We have had many research publications from this work and this summer were also featured in the Times and the Daily Mail 'How counting steps can protect heart years later'.

Thanks to all those who took part in the PACE-Lift trial - you were the very important first step!!
